**Learning Activity:** Nature walk

## Big Idea:

How do our senses help us to find out about our world?

## What to do:

Wrap up warm and go out for a walk with your child(ren), talk to your child about the things you can see around you. Point to and name things you see, collect some treasures from the floor and take them home with you. Back at home look at your treasures and name them and use them to talk about what you saw and did on your walk. You could also use them to make a memory picture or a book using your treasures.
